2021 Application Instructions

Dear Applicant,

With interest in helping young people fulfill their calling to serve in missions, Mission Wings International, Inc has developed the Wesley J Warden Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Wesley J Warden served over thirty years in Honduras as a living example of a true follower of Christ. His legacy and work provided the foundation that has allowed MissionWings to begin establishing a work in Honduras.

The **mission** of Mission Wings International, Inc is to alleviate human suffering in the face of poverty, emergencies, and disasters while being witnesses... unto the uttermost part of the earth.

The purpose of this scholarship fund is to aid students with a call to serve in missions in fulfilling the financial obligations of their education and training.

This scholarship preferences those preparing to serve in mission aviation but is not solely dedicated to those students and will grant scholarships to any student preparing to serve in a missionary capacity, if

1) no missionary aviation applications have been received,

Or

2) the missionary aviation applicants have failed to successfully present to the selection committee the merit necessary for receiving the scholarship.

The Wesley J Warden Memorial Scholarship fund will reward up to a maximum of 3 scholarships per year. The max award amount is \$10,000. The maximum value of accumulated awards any single recipient may receive from the Wesley J Warden Memorial Scholarship is \$20,000.

The dollar amount and the quantity of the scholarships awarded each year will be dependent on the balance of funds available for distribution in the Wesley J Warden Memorial Scholarship Fund.

2021 is the first year that this scholarship has been made available, and we will be awarding one scholarship of **\$300.00**.

Criteria and Eligibility

1. Applicants must be enrolled in a missions program at one of the following schools and have finished at least one semester of study with evidence of intent of completing the course of study.

- Penn View Bible Institute
- Hobe Sound Bible College
- God's Bible School
- Allegheny Wesleyan College
- Union Bible College

Or.

Completed a minimum of 2 years of missionary, ministerial or Biblical studies at one of the above-listed schools while being enrolled in missionary aviation maintenance training at the School of Missionary Aviation Technology or the apprentice course at MMS Aviation or enrolled in missionary flight training at either the School of Missionary Aviation Technology or Clearflight Aviation.

3. Applicants must have an average GPA of 2.7

4. Applicants must not be an immediate relative of any director, officer, committee member, or substantial contributor of Mission Wings International, Inc.

Application Process

The Applicant must submit the following items:

1. A letter of introduction addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain an introduction of yourself, your college, and explain your future education plans. The letter should not exceed one (1) page.

2. A completed application form. (If handwritten, please print legibly; if not legible, the application will not be considered)
3. A portrait photograph
4. An official college transcript of your cumulative grade point average. Current aviation students must also include official transcripts or an official progress report from your flight or AMT school.
5. An official letter from your school verifying current enrollment status.
6. A personal essay:
 - The essay must be at least three (3) full single-sided typed pages, double-spaced, 12 pt Times New Roman font with one (1) inch margins.
 - The essay shall contain no grammatical errors.
 - The essay shall explain the Applicant's current activities, short-term goals, and any ministry involvement.
 - The essay shall explain the applicants and long-term plans and goals.
 - The essay shall provide a summary of the Applicant's worldview.
 - The essay must also describe the Applicant's current financial status, explaining why they believe they should be the recipient of the scholarship, and how it will help them achieve their goals.

The quality of this essay is essential. The more information you provide about your current plans, what your goals in life are, and your worldview, the better. The longer the essay, the better, but do not be wordy.

7. At least three (3) letters of recommendation from a choice of teachers, professors, administrators, counselors, employers, or an individual with significant knowledge of the Applicant's experience, character, and plans. The references must not be a pastor or family member.
 - The letters of recommendation should provide insight into the Applicant's character, work ethic, sincerity, and determination to achieving their goals.
 - The reference must submit the letters of recommendation through the scholarship page on MissionWings website found at www.missionwings.org/scholarships

*It is the Applicant's responsibility to source their references, inform them of the above requirements, and verify that their references have submitted their letters of recommendation by the deadline.

Completed **Three (3) Letters of Recommendation.** Verify your references have submitted their letters of recommendation before submitting your application.

22. **Submit your application by March 15th, 2021.** We recommend that you plan to submit your application well before the deadline.

STATEMENT OF ACCURACY & ACCEPTANCE OF SCHOLARSHIP TERMS

I hereby affirm that all the above-stated information provided by me is true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I also understand that if chosen as a scholarship recipient, according to the Wesley J Warden Memorial Scholarship Fund policy, I must remain enrolled full-time and in good standing with the school over the next academic year. Any financial liability, to my school of enrollment, created by the revocation of a scholarship because of violation of the scholarship terms' is the my responsibility. I also consent that my picture may be taken and used to promote the scholarship program.

The Wesley J Warden Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to the recipients during their school's annual commencement ceremony. The recipients will also be announced on Mission Wings International, Inc website by June 15th. A representative from Mission Wings International, Inc may or may not be present to issue the award. During the absence of a Mission Wings International, Inc representative, the award will be presented by the school's Missions Program Director.

Mission Wings International, Inc will transfer scholarship rewards to the student's school of enrollment to be applied directly to the student's account.
