This location is ideal because not only is it the most favorable place for an airstrip within the district of Copán, it is also near the location where we have a house. It is looking very promising that we will gain this permission. We are thankful to God that we have favorability with the mayor of Concepción and that he is pulling the strings in our favor. Pray that we receive this permission and for the needed funds and help to construct this airstrip and hanger.

Great things are happening in Papua New Guinea and the opportunity for us to work in that country is enormous. We wish to be a blessing and a tool to be used in advancing the Kingdom of God in that part of the world.
